PHARMACY FIRST SERVICE - COMING IN JANUARY

The current pharmacy referral service (CPCS) is being replaced by an advanced service called Pharmacy First. The change is due to happen on 31st January.

Pharmacy First is a walk-in service but the surgery can refer you if this is the best way to treat your problem. Under this service pharmacies will offer everything they did under CPCS, but will soon be able to give advice and provide NHS medicines to treat 7 common health conditions:

- Sinusitis
- Sore throat
- Ear infection
- Infected insect bites
- Impetigo
- Shingles
- UTIs (in women)

Please keep an eye out for updates as we get more information on which pharmacies will be involved.

Although the Pharmacy First service aims to help patients get the care they need quickly, it may not be right for some conditions. If you are pregnant, or your problem has been going on for more than 2 weeks, please contact the surgery (01626 334411) to make an appointment with one of our clinicians.
